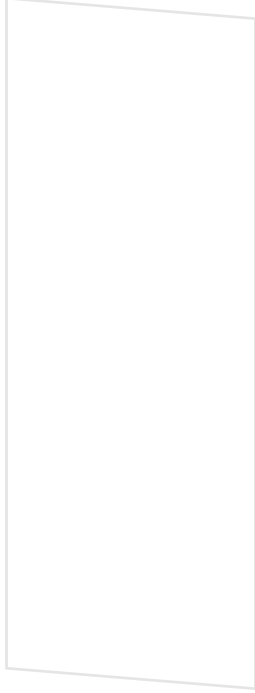

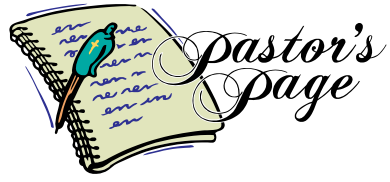

all hearts beat as one!

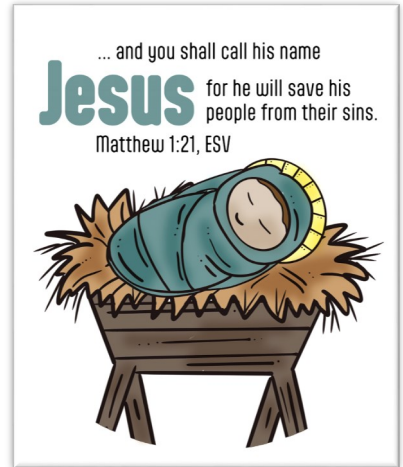
